HURON MAN SENTENCED TO 28 YEARS TO LIFE FOR THE RAPE OF A JUVENILE

A 34-year-old Huron man has been sentenced to 28 years to life for repeatedly sexually assaulting a child from 2008 to 2010 in Delaware County. He's also been classified as a Tier III sex offender.

"While we can't undo the trauma to this child, we can make sure this man never offends again," said Delaware County Prosecutor Melissa Schiffel. "We thank the Delaware County Sheriff's Office for its thorough investigation and efforts to bring this man to justice."

Eric Joseph Bellamy was indicted in January 2019 on 10 charges including rape, gross sexual imposition, and menacing by stalking. After a three-day trial, a jury found Bellamy guilty on all counts. The crimes occurred while Bellamy resided in Delaware County. The victim was under the age of 10.

DELAWARE MAN SENTENCED FOR HIT/SKIP INVOLVING PEDESTRIAN

Devon T. Tosco was sentenced to 15 months in prison for hitting a pedestrian with his vehicle in downtown Delaware and driving away from the scene on March 16, 2019.

Tosco pled guilty to vehicular assault and not stopping after an accident in July. In addition to time in prison, the court ordered his driver's license be suspended for eight years.
