COLUMBUS MAN HEADED TO PRISON FOR INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER

Paul Baxter Curry was sentenced to 5 to 7.5 years in prison for the overdose death of a 47-year-old Delaware man.

Text messages and surveillance video link Curry to the victim, and show that Curry facilitated the drug deal that ultimately proved fatal. The victim was found deceased inside his Delaware home on February 4, 2020. The official cause of death was fentanyl intoxication.

Curry was indicted in July and pled guilty in December 2020 to F1 involuntary manslaughter. In addition to the 5 to 7.5 years in prison, the court ordered Curry to complete an additional 5 years post release control monitoring upon his release from prison.
