-Gary Hall was sentenced to 2.5 years community control sanctions for attempted felonious assault. -Anthony Dickson was found guilty after a jury trial of disrupting public services. Sentencing is set for 1/30/23.

-Michael Trupiano was sentenced to 1 year in prison for domestic violence.

-Joelle Cooper was sentenced to 2 years community control sanctions for improperly furnishing firearms to a minor, failure to comply with an order or signal of a police officer, and discharge of a firearm on or near prohibited premises. As part of her sentence, her driver's license will be suspended for 1 year.
