**MULTIPLE CAR BREAK-INS RESULT IN
MULTI-COUNT INDICTMENT FOR TWO**

A Delaware County Grand Jury returned a 7-count indictment against 25-year-old Andrew Johnson and 23-year-old Michael Shanahan.

“Mr. Johnson and Mr. Shanahan allegedly stole property out of the cars of several Powell residents,” said Delaware County Prosecutor Carol O’Brien. “Examples of items reported stolen include checkbooks, a credit card, bank card, and debit card.”

Johnson, of Powell, and Shanahan, of Upper Arlington, are each charged with 7 counts of theft – all fifth-degree felonies.

Arrest warrants have been issued for both Johnson and Shanahan. An arraignment date has not yet been set.

**LEWIS CENTER WOMAN INDICTED AFTER
FORMER EMPLOYER DISCOVERS FUNDS ARE MISSING**

A Delaware County Grand Jury returned a 12-count indictment against 55-year-old Rachel Richey, a former Central Marketing Associates employee.

“Ms. Richey was a bookkeeper with Central Marketing Associates for years,” said Delaware County Prosecutor, Carol O’Brien. “As such, she had access to financial information and clearance to write checks.”

Richey is charged with 1 count of aggravated theft – a third-degree felony, 1 count of tampering with records – a third-degree felony, and 10 counts of forgery – all fourth-degree felonies. All charges specify a timeframe of August 1, 2008 through June 1, 2012.

The exact amount of money involved remains under investigation.

An arrest warrant has been issued for Richey.
