William Durham was sentenced to 9 years in prison for his role in stealing thousands of dollars from local PNC patrons.

Durham and two accomplices illegally obtained personal financial information from multiple bank patrons and used that information to withdraw more than \$100,000 from customer accounts.

A jury found Durham guilty of:

- F1 engaging in a pattern of corrupt activity,
- F3 telecommunications fraud,
- F4 theft,
- F3 tampering with records,
- F3 identity fraud, and
- F4 forgery.

The crimes took place from June 22, 2017 through August 8, 2017 and involved PNC branches in Columbus, Cleveland, Cincinnati, and Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Restitution was ordered in the case.
