Delaware Man Found Guilty of Domestic Violence

Earlier this month, a jury found Tony Price guilty of one count of domestic violence, a fourth-degree felony, for assaulting his partner. At the time of this incident, Price was already on probation for a misdemeanor domestic violence charge through the Delaware Municipal Court. Price was ultimately sentenced to five years community control for this second domestic violence conviction.

“No doubt our office has seen an uptick in the number of felony domestic violence cases this year, in large part due to the pandemic and stay at home orders.” Delaware County Prosecutor Melissa Schiffel said. “With the dedication of our law enforcement officers and domestic violence prosecutor, we fight to hold offenders accountable.
