



Court Update: August 28 – September 15, 2023

- Lloyd Keeton was sentenced to 9 years in prison for eight counts of breaking and entering, 3 counts of theft, 4 counts of safecracking, vandalism and possession of criminal tools.
- Collin Sizemore was sentenced to 6-7 years in prison for 2 counts of breaking and entering, 3 counts of theft, receiving stolen property, burglary, and 3 counts of grand theft.
- Jessica Muddiman was sentenced to 12 months in prison for 3 counts of passing bad checks.
- Skeeter Pierce was sentenced to 6 months in prison for breaking and entering and grand theft.
- William C. Roberts was sentenced to 180 days in jail plus 4 years community control sanctions for strangulation.
- Gregory Kniemeyer was sentenced to 90 days in jail plus 90 days community control sanctions for abusing harmful intoxicants.
- Benjamin Russell was sentenced to 3 years community control sanctions for aggravated assault.
- Joseph Gatewood was sentenced to 2 years community control sanctions for violating a protection order.
- Kevin Demetro was sentenced to 12 months community control sanctions for grand theft.
