

## Court Update: August 1-26, 2022

-Emanuel Carrillo was sentenced to 11-16.5 years in prison for trafficking in a fentanyl related compound.

-William Barnes III was sentenced to 3-4.5 years in prison for improperly discharging a firearm at or into a habitation or a school safety zone.

-Damien Miracle was sentenced to 2-3.5 years in prison for aggravated possession of drugs.

-Villardia Pierre was sentenced to 36 months in prison for aggravated vehicular assault.

-Kyle Holden was sentenced to 4 years community control sanctions, with 60 days in jail, for abduction.

-Patrick Hess was sentenced to 4 years community control sanctions for felonious assault and failure to stop after an accident. -Joshua Phelps was sentenced to 8-12 years in prison for rape.
