



Court Update: October 3-21, 2022

- Tod Kohler was sentenced to 8 years in prison for sexual battery x2 and gross sexual imposition x2.
- David Craig was sentenced to 4 years community control sanctions for possession of a fentanyl-related compound and aggravated possession of drugs.
- Larry Diehl was sentenced to 3 years community control sanctions for domestic violence.
- Larry Edwards was sentenced to 3 years community control sanctions for domestic violence.
- Claude Thacker was sentenced to 2.5 years community control sanctions for receiving stolen property.
- Emily Melendez-Perez was sentenced to 2 years community control sanctions for child endangering.
- Muata Fisher was found guilty after a jury trial of Rape x8 and gross sexual imposition. Sentencing is set for 11/1/21.

Our Victim Services Unit handled 12 walk-ins and 75 calls and/or emails referring to civil protection orders, violations, referrals, or safety planning.

Court Update: October 24-28, 2022

- Xavier Jackson was sentenced to 6-8 years in prison for felonious assault with a gun specification x2.
- Jorian Trimble was sentenced to 18 months in prison for having a weapon under disability.
- Cierra Lewis was sentenced to 120 days in jail for possession of a fentanyl related compound.
- James Thomas was sentenced to 3 years community control sanctions for aggravated possession of drugs.
- Henry Dishmon III was sentenced to 2.5 years community control sanctions with 75 days in jail for menacing by stalking.
- William Houston was sentenced to 2.5 years community control sanctions for attempted robbery.
- Thomas Bennett was sentenced to 2.5 years of community control sanctions for improperly handling a firearm in a motor vehicle and operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Stacey Barnes was sentenced to 2 years community control sanctions for aggravated possession of drugs.
